Mercer Co. Right to Life's Bus Trip to Kettering Abortion Clinic Tuesday, October 13th:

(This Newsletter went to press on 10/12). In conjunction with the "40 Days for Life" Fall Campaign" as of today, 20 members from our Mercer County area (many for the first time) will visit the Kettering Abortion Clinic. **Our faithful leader, Marie Heitkamp said, her numbers change daily! On Tuesday morning, whoever gets on the bus goes. Marie stated that Our job is to pray for those entering the Abortion Mill.**

Shawn Carney, 40 Days for Life Campaign Director, stated that 55 million babies have been aborted in the United States since the Roe V. Wade Supreme Court decision in 1973. And, abortion strikes closer to home than we think. 40 Days for Life is striving to "end Abortion", one heart, one mind, one life and one community at a time. He recently wrote that the campaigns began as a local effort in 2004 in response to a Planned Parenthood abortion facility opening in Bryan/College Station, TX. By 2007, we were already in 89 cities. Since then, we've expanded to 3,558 vigil sites in 579 cities across all fifty states and now in 30 countries. As a result: 10,331 babies have been saved from abortion (that we know of); 118 abortion workers have been converted; 60 abortion facilities completely shut down. Countless pro-life Americans have been praying and fasting for an end to abortion and thousands of church congregations have stood up for life.

Breaking News: LifeSiteNews reveals that the Ohio Department of Health made a deal with Planned Parenthood and another abortion provider to help them remain open. LifeSiteNews reports that "Judge Barrett's order reveals that the state and the abortionists made a behind-the-scenes deal: ODH would intentionally issue its denial of license exception before the new law went into effect, with the result that the abortionists would be able to stay in business

"It is time for the administration to stop playing games with children's lives" said Molly Smith, President of Cleveland Right to Life. "Making laws that are then manipulated by the very people who make them is unacceptable and the Governor and the ODH needs to understand that Ohio prolife citizens expect more from our much touted prolife administration."

Over 100 group state wide have formed a coalition and nearly 3,000 individuals to ask the Governor to end tax payer funding of all abortions not just Medicaid funding to Planned Parenthood. The groups are demanding that all government funding for abortion must end from all government departments.

The U.S. Senate's vote on the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act was a *milestone in the fight to protect life.* It was also the culmination of years of work. While we did not garner the 60 votes necessary to pass the bill, we did secure 54 votes a majority! It was the first time that the Senate has taken up this lifesaving legislation and rest assured, it will not be the last. We will continue our battle to enact this lifesaving legislation the debate over which changes hearts and minds. Last month, the American people witnessed an important debate on the Senate floor. Senator after senator spoke out in favor of defending Life and taking the U.S. off the list of only seven countries to allow abortion after five months. A bright spot in the debate was Senator Portman. He said: "I urge my colleagues on both sides of the aisle to help provide a voice for those who cannot provide that voice for themselves, to take this important step toward standing up for the sanctity of life."
